# Itinerary - first day adult tour sample

## Arrival

Pick up guests at Pearson International Airport. We will safely transport them in our passenger van to their beautiful bed and breakfast in downtown Toronto. We will check them into the B&B, ensuring that they are settled in and comfortable. All guests will stay at the same B&B and will have the opportunity to get to know each other and build friendships throughout their stay.

## Daily organization

- 8 AM** Everyday begins with a generous, self catered full breakfast at the B&B.
- 9 AM** Orientation begins. We will go through and explain the itinerary for the week and review all handouts which include maps, lessons and worksheets. We will also have an introduction session that will allow guests to get to know each other better.
- 10 AM** Language lesson for the day begins. Each day we will concentrate on a new language goal that will include target vocabulary and a specific grammar structure. These language focuses can be applied throughout the day while visiting local sightseeing spots, points of interest, and during dining and evening outings.
- 12 PM** Lunch will be served at a local restaurant.
- 1 PM** Sightseeing tour begins. We will take our guests to the sightseeing spots of the day. There will be as many as 4 depending on location and weather. At each spot, we will explain the history, culture and interesting facts and features of the area. This will also be a time to go over questions, allowing guests to engage in conversation thus applying language learned and/or just enjoy the surroundings.
- 5 PM** Dinner will be served at a selected restaurant.
- 7 PM** The special evening event begins. The special event will vary depend on season and weather. Events will range from sporting events, live performances, themed bars and clubs and outdoor activities.

\*Tuesday to Friday - morning sightseeing will start at 10AM after the morning lesson.

\*Saturday will be a free-day where the guests will be able to do anything they wish.
